Police investigate shooting death

Robbery, suicide both ruled out in death in Sandelwood area

BLUE SPRINGS — Police are investigating the shoeting death of a 45-year-old voman Monday afternoon.

The body of Katherine Middleton was found in the dining room of her home inner the 1400 block of Worth 48th Street in the Sandelwood subdivision at approximately Jam. The man was visibly uppet as he left the house, and he collapsed on the driveway, sobbing hysterically.

Sgt. Jeff Rogers said police believe they have the weapon that was involved in the shooting. Rogers said it didn't appear that the shooting was the result of a robbery or juicide.

An autopsy was scheduled for this morning. Police said the autopsy results, expected this afternoon, would provide key information about what happened. Neighbors said they didn't know much

about the couple. They said the Middletons generally kept to themselves. Mark Engstrom, who lives in the house south of the Middletons, said today that Middleton is a truck driver and hadn't

"It was a real surprise to me," Engstrom
said. "Nothing like that has ever happened
in our neighborhood before."

Terry Kratz, who lives across the street,
said the Middletons owned a farm near Ne-

Neighbors said a young niece or grandniece has been staying with the Middletons and was in school at the time of the shooting. A school bus dropped off the girl

at the corner of 48th Street and Valley View Road at 3:10 p.m. Wednesday. Kratz, his wife and other neighbors met the girl at the street corner, where police told her there had been an accident. She stayed at the Kratz home until relatives came and picked her up later Wednesday

afternoon.

Kratz said when the little girl got off the bus she was surprised that Middleton was home.
